CPESC, INC. REORGANIZED AS ENVIROCERT INTERNATIONAL, INC. TO BETTER SERVE THE NEEDS OF ITS REGISTRANTS

Marion, N.C -- The former Certified Professionals in Erosion and Sediment Control (CPESC) Inc. is pleased to announce a reorganization of our corporate structure to better serve the needs of its registrants, the erosion and sediment control and storm water management industries, the regulatory community, and the interests of the public at large.

Over a year ago, the CPESC, Inc. Council conducted an efficiency audit of our operations. One of the changes recommended was to reorganize our certification programs such that each program was independent of the others and to operate these programs under an umbrella corporation. We have now created an umbrella corporation, EnviroCert International, Inc., which officially took over on April 1, 2008. CPSWQ, Inc. and CESSWI, Inc. have already been created. CPESC, Inc. was already a non-profit organization. This is our initial structure under EnviroCert International, Inc.

Another recommendation of the study consultant was that we break our exams and exam review courses from the certification bodies into an educational body. The educational body has yet to be created, but plans are underway to make this a reality. We will seek to have this entity designated 501(c)3 which will enable it to accept tax deductible donations and grants.

Over 3000 professionals in Erosion and Sediment Control and Storm Water Quality have been certified in the past quarter century. EnviroCert International, Inc. plans to continue its certification expertise and excellence over the next quarter century.
